The Pandemic has a particularly negative impact on:

2) women who work in the care sector where they form the majority of employees and are directly affected by Covid-19 at the same time that their unpaid care-work is increasing; 3) the security of women, as social isolation exponentially increased gender specific (as well as domestic/intimate partner) violence whilst support and preventative services are out of order or made inaccessible; 4) as well as the reduced access to services for sexual and reproductive health.
